After a satisfying banquet at the Horizon Restaraunt,

President Barto opened the meeting.

Sec. Stevenson read the minutes of the Lewistown meeting and the Treasurers Report, both of which were accepted with his notes.

Hank Brandt, president of the Great Fallls Chess Club presented a plaque to the Association in behalf of the Great Falls Club. This plaque contains a space to engrave the name of each year's winner and is to be given to the champion to keep for one year after which it will be turned over to the new champion.

The matter of next year's tournament was brought up and both Butte and Deer Lodge were proposed as sites. After some discussion it was voted to give it to Deer Lodge.

Mr. and Mrs. Paul Shanely² were unanimously elected president and secretary respectively.

The question of whether or not to admit non-residents of Montana to future tournaments was discussed at length and finally a motion was passed to keep the tournament open to all.

Affiliation with the U. S. Chess Federation was explained and discussed pro and con but no definite action was taken on it

All present seemed to favor the continuation of the single class Swiss system for our state tourney. While no motion was made it appeared to be the general understanding that next year's tournament will be run on the same lines as this one.

President elect Shanely spoke briefly inviting all present to attend next year at Deer Lodge.

President Barto called attention to the low cost of this tournament and urged future officers to try to keep costs

as low as possible.

The meeting was adjourned at this point to continue play.

At the conclusion of the tournament cups were presented to champion Van Teylingen and runner-up Southern. The placque was also placed in Van's custody till next year.
