CHESS PLAYERS:

The Butte Chess Club as host welcomes you to attend the 35th Annual Tournament of the Montana Chess Association which will be held on Saturday and Sunday April 25 and 26, 1970 in the Finlen Hotel here in Butte, Montana.

Competition will be conducted in the following three classes:

- Class A - Open to all, but we suggest for players of above average ability. Trophies for the top three places.
- Class B - Open to all who do not wish to play in Class A, however previous first place winners in this class must compete in Class A. Trophies for first three places.
- Junior Class - Entry limited to players under 18 years of age on April 25, 1970; previous first place winners in this class must play in Classes A or B. Trophies for top two places.

A 5 Round Swiss Tournament will be conducted in each class under time control of 50 moves in the first 2 hours and 25 moves per hour thereafter. Games not completed before the next round will be adjourned with a sealed move and considered as draws for next round pairings. Adjourned games must be completed at the earliest convenient time during the tournament. Where required, tie-breaking will be by the Median, Solkoff and S - B points in that order.

Entry fees for Classes A and B will be \$3.00 per player, Junior Class entry fee is \$1.50. Entry fees may be paid in advance by mail to the Secretary or at the registration desk on Saturday morning April 25, 1970.

The Annual Dinner Meeting of the Montana Chess Association will be held in the Finlen Hotel's Treasure State Room at 6:30 p.m., Saturday, April 25. All players, their relatives or friends are welcome to attend at the charge of \$3.50 per person. This charge should be paid at the time you register for the tournament.

The Butte Chess Club will serve a free complimentary Buffet Lunch to all players on Sunday, April 26, at 12:00 noon.

The enclosed reservation card is for your convenience should you wish to stay at the Finlen Hotel or Motel, this card can be mailed directly to the Finlen Hotel. Reservations will be made on request at other local hotels or motels.


