KIP STUBBERUD SNARES MONTANA TITLE TO TOP MONTANA OPEN VICTORY

Kip Stubberud scored four wins against one loss to win the Montana Championship playoff which was held in conjunction with the Midsummer Open in Missoula on July 14-15. Phil Heikkinen, who scored the lone win over Kip, finished one half point back after losing a hard game to Paul Motta in the final round. Motta, who had to be favored going into the competition due to his marvelous string of successes in the past year, had to settle for third place with a 3-2 score after losing with the Black pieces to both Kip and last year's Champion Mike Jensen. Jensen placed fourth with $2\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$ while Bill Lynch ($1\frac{1}{2}$) and Ron Erickso ($\frac{1}{2}$) trailed. Stubberud regained the title which he previously held outright in 1980, and in three way ties in 1981 and 1987. A full report on the Championship will appear next issue.

Stubberud qualified for the playoff with his undefeated 4-1 score in the Montana Open, placing first on tie-breaks over Paul Motta, Bill Lynch and Phil Heikkinen. The cross-table from that tournament along with selected games appears on page 2. Note especially the final position in Stubberud-Loy from Round 5. Kip was able to calmly accept Jim's resignation and sign the scoresheets before showing Jim that ...Rxc7+ wins for Black! Study and hard work are necessary, but a little bit of good fortune never hurts!

MOTTA GETS LEG UP ON GRAND PRIX WITH BOZEMAN OPEN WIN

Paul Motta placed first in a small but very strong tournament in Bozeman in June. Ron Matous made a bid for first on day one with wins over Zygmund Mayer and Phil Heikkinen, but then fell to Paul and Kip Stubberud on Sunday. Motta had to work hard, with all of his games going past 40 moves. Stubberud finished strong to take second with 3-2. The final standings and some game scores are on page 3. The contest between Mayer and Stubberud in round 2 is an example of a "fighting draw" - look it over.

WYOMING / MONTANA MATCH SCHEDULED

The inaugural match between Montana and Wyoming will be played in West Yellowstone in September. MCA President Paul Motta after discussions with other MCA officers decided to view the Montana Open as a "qualifier", and invite players from each class who did well there. Alternates will be chosen if these players are unavailable for the team of 10-14 players which Wyoming hopes to match. Arrangement details are on page 4.

POSTAL CHAMPIONSHIP NEARING CONCLUSION

The 1989-90 Montana Postal Championship is winding down with just 7 games of 36 still in progress. Paul Motta has completed his games and leads with $5\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$, while Bill Lynch has a $4\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ score with 2 games remaining.
