- Open Section: Open to all USCF members and new members. Entry Fee = \$6. USCF and MCA membership required, may join at site. USCF - \$20 Adult, \$10 Jr., \$2.50 Participating Jr. MCA - \$4 Adult, \$3 Jr. COMBINED - \$20 Adult, \$10 Jr., \$4 PJr. Prizes to be announced - most of proceeds will be used to promote a master exhibition at the 1981 Montana Open Tournament.
