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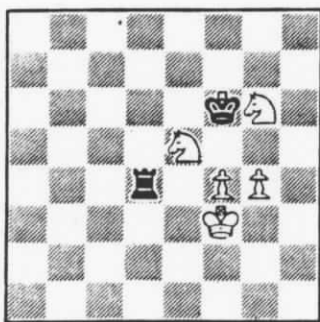
Going into the fall tournaments, Jim Loy has a narrow 35-32 point lead over Mike Jensen in the 1983 Montana Grand Prix standings. Kip Stubberud is well back in third place with an 18 point total, followed by Howard Hoene in fourth with 15 points and Romie Carpenter and Darren Stacey tied for fifth with 12 each. Stewart Sutton, Herman Chiu and Bill Lynch round out the players in double figures with 10 apiece. Bill Egger stands alone in tenth position at 8. John Hay, Phil Heikkinen and John Thompson each ahs 7 points and 14th-15th is shared by Al Williams and Matt Guthrie who both have 5 points.

Several reforms have been proposed in the procedures and formulas to be used in the Grand Prix competition - which will be reviewed for proposing a change at next year's MCA business meeting. Meanwhile, the 1983 competition will be concluded on December 31, 1983 and points will be awarded (10-7-5-3-2-1) to the 1st-6th place finishers in Open tournaments advertised statewide as has been the case in the past.

I've been practicing on Chess 7.0, a commercial chess program, on my Apple Computer. They're getting better. Here are two of my losses against Chess 7.0, on level 5 (1 to 3 minutes/move):
