MONTANA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYOFF: Dates and site not yet determined. Qualified players are as follows: 1987 Champion - John Thompson, Billings (on tie breaker); 1987-88 Grand Prix Champion - Paul Motta, Ennis; 2ND Place Grand Prix - Romie Carpenter, Missoula; Top Three Montana Open - Les Brennan, Colstrip; Bill Greer, Ashland; and Arman Goplen, Kalispell. 1st Alternate - Dan Britt, Missoula. 2nd Alternate - Bob Phillips, Ronan. Preliminary consensus amongst those present at the Montana Open was to play in Ennis, but all in favor have changed their minds, as I understand it. The qualifiers are to agree on a date and site, with any dispute resolved by MCA Pres. Dennis Petrak.

ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING: Did not take place at the Montana Open! As it turned out, not one of the Association officers was present to conduct the meeting. Thus, the present officers remain and the site for the 1989 Montana Open has not been selected. I have heard that Dennis Petrak has proposed the business meeting be held at the Chinook Open. Official notice will be in the next issue of MCN. I had sent a preliminary treasurer's report to Missoula showing the Association balance to be \$422.48 to which must be added membership fees collected at the open, compared to \$325.30 the previous year. - ED
